Where is French Polynesia located?

French Polynesia (/ˈpʰɪniːz/ ⓘ) POL-ih-NEE-zh?; French: Polynésie française [pʰɛnezɪ fʁɑ̃ˈsɛːz](i); Tahitian: Porinetia Farani) is an overseas collectivity of France and its sole overseas country. It comprises 121 geographically dispersed islands and atolls [5] stretching over more than 2,000 kilometres (1,200 mi) in the South Pacific Ocean.

Is French Polynesia a self-governing country?

French Polynesia was relisted in the United Nations list of non-self-governing territories in 2013, making it eligible for a UN-backed independence referendum.

Who was the first European to visit French Polynesia?

Ferdinand MAGELLAN was the first European to see the islands of French Polynesia in 1520, and successive European voyagers traveled through them over the next two centuries.

Who has power in French Polynesia?

Executive power is exercised by the government. Legislative power is vested in both the government and the Assembly of French Polynesia (the territorial assembly). Political life in French Polynesia was marked by great instability from the mid-2000s to the mid-2010s.

Could French Polynesia & New Caledonia make a similar offer to Tuvalu?

Tuvalu has a population of 11,000, and its low-lying atolls make it particularly vulnerable to global warming. Colonna said she was not sure if the French Pacific territories of French Polynesia and New Caledonia had the capacity to make similar offers. "I'm open to consider any specific request," Colonna told the National Press Club of Australia.
