

Can a washing machine be placed in the middle of a locker

Where should you put a washing machine?

The truth is, there's no single 'correct' place to put a washing machine. There are, however, certain conditions you've got to meet before you can set up your washer. There needs to be the necessary pipework in place for water and drainage purposes, as well as access to electricity. Obviously, you also need to choose a safe place for the appliance.

Where should I put my washing machine socket?

Given the fact that your washing needs power to work, you must put it near a power outlet. However, here in the UK, there are rules and regulations on where you can place sockets. One of these rules is that you cannot put an electricity socket within three metres of a shower or bath.
