Can polystyrene boxes be used to grow food?

Polystyrene boxes can indeed be used to grow food. It is important to note that polystyrene is different from PVC, polyvinyl chloride, which can release toxic substances like dioxin, lead, and phthalates. Polystyrene boxes are not the same as water pipes, which are made from PVC.

Can you store cold food in plastic containers?

The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics in the US, the world's largest organisation of food and nutrition professionals, advises consumers to only use plastic containers to store cold food. Most plastic food containers have a triangle on the bottom containing a number from one to seven, which identifies the type of plastic used to make it.

Which plastics do not leach toxic chemicals into food?

#4 Low-density polyethylene (LDPE) (sealable sandwich bags, plastic cling wrap, squeezable condiment bottles): These plastics do not leach toxic chemicals into food, but some municipal recyclers do not accept them. #5 Polypropylene (PP) (yogurt containers, reusable plastic snack containers): These containers do not leach toxic chemicals into food.
