What is the purpose of the Electricity Ordinance in Hong Kong?

Abstract: The Electricity Ordinance (Cap. 406) in Hong Kong aims at protecting the general public at large in the use of electricity, which is supplied through generation, transmission and distribution. There are a number of subsidiary regulations enacted under the Electricity Ordinance.

Who provides electricity in Hong Kong?

There are two main providers of electricity in Hong Kong. Power generation in Hong Kong is managed by two major companies under a Scheme of Control arrangement with the Hong Kong Government. These companies effectively operate in a regulated market.

Does CLP own power stations in Hong Kong?

CLP's supply area includes Kowloon,New Territories and outlying islands except Lamma Island. CLP owns the following power stations in Hong Kong territoryunder a joint-venture company Castle Peak Power Company Limited (CAPCO) with China Southern Power Grid International (HK) Co.,Limited.

How much electricity does Hong Kong use?

Electricity usage based on industry in Hong Kong are 66% (commercial),26% (residential),6% (industrial) and 2% (transportation). Peak demand of electricity use was 9.942 GW. ^a b c d e f g h i "Hong Kong Energy Statistics 2021 Annual Report" (PDF).
