Where can I stay in Cocos (Keeling)?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands have a few accommodation options on both islands, however, most options are located on West Island. Resorts, high-rises, there's none to be found here. Cocos can only accommodate 144 people at any given time, with most options simple digs.

What is Cocos Keeling Island?

What is it? The Cocos Keeling Islands are an atoll of 27 small islands, with only two inhabited by people - West Island and Home Island. Outside of those two there are 25 others just waiting to be discovered, including the tiny Prison Island and Direction Island - home to Cossie's Beach - crowned the Best Beach in Australia in 2017.

How many people live in the Cocos Keeling Islands?

The islands are home to a tiny population of around 600 mostly Cocos Malays - the predominant community of the region. Where is it? Lying smack bang in the middle of the Indian Ocean, the Cocos Keeling Islands are about 2800km northwest of Perth and 900km southwest of Christmas Island.
