What are energy scams?

Energy scams involve people pretending to be energy companies or regulators to get your money or personal information. These scammers may pretend to be your energy company, say they're from Ofgem or even from Energy Saving Trust to try and gain your trust.

Are fake emails claiming a discount on energy bills a scam?

People are being warned to look out for fake emails and texts claiming to offer discounts on energy bills. A number of different scams have been circulating, including some that appear to be from the energy regulator Ofgem. The government has announced that a £400 energy bill discount will be available to all households.

Do energy suppliers & the police take energy scams seriously?

Energy suppliers and the police take energy scams seriously, and have systems in place to help tackle fraud. There has been a spike in doorstep and cold-calling crime as well as energy-related fraud including individuals either calling, emailing, or texting consumers claiming to be from the Government or an energy supplier.

How do I report an energy scam?

They might try to contact you by: text message. These are energy scams. Ofgem would never sell you energy, ask for personal information or come to your property. Report the scam to Action Fraud, the reporting centre for fraud and cyber-crime in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. In Scotland, contact Police Scotland on 101.

How did scammers use the £400 government energy bill rebate?

Scammers used the £400 government energy bill rebate, known as the Energy Bills Support Scheme, to trick people into handing over their details. This scheme ended for most households in March 2023, and payments would have come directly from your electricity supplier.

How much does energy theft cost UK?

Energy theft also costs energy consumers in Great Britain (England, Scotland and Wales) over £1.4 billion a year. If you see signs of meter tampering, you should report it. When you report energy theft, you will stay completely anonymous. You can report energy theft online via Stay Energy Safe or call 0800 023 2777.
