French Polynesia, like most island territories, is highly dependent on hydrocarbon imports. In 2019, 93.8% of energy consumed in the archipelagos came from imports of various petroleum-based fuels. The renewable energy penetration rate in power generation stood at 28.78% in 2019. This figure has remained stable over the last five years.

The winter in French Polynesia experiences very rapidly decreasing cloud cover, with the percentage of time that the sky is overcast or mostly cloudy decreasing from 41% to 24%. The lowest chance of overcast or mostly cloudy conditions is 22% on August 20.. The clearest day of the winter is August 20, with clear, mostly clear, or partly cloudy conditions 78% of the time.
