Boat users in Guernsey are being warned to be aware of the dangers of lithium-ion batteries and keeping them safely. Guernsey Ports said it was issuing the warning following an increase in ...

Guernsey Ports assistant harbourmaster Kieran Higgs said these batteries need to be treated differently to other power sources. "Understanding the correct safety procedures is important as the consequences of a battery fire can be catastrophic," he said. "Thermal runaway is the cause of most lithium-ion battery fires.

Lithium Battery Mark must be applied. The sender's name and return address must be clearly visible on the outer packaging. These items must be presented at a Guernsey Post branch. Lithium metal cells and batteries must: Be ...

Lithium batteries. Found in watches, calculators, e-cigarettes, computer tablets, laptops, digital cameras, mobile phones and other small electrical items. Households can drop off any items that contain batteries and the batteries themselves free of charge at the Household Waste & Recycling Centre at Longue Hougue.

**To convert a golf cart to 36V lithium batteries:** Choose a 36V lithium battery (preferably LiFePO<sub>4</sub>) with adequate capacity. The formula is Lithium Battery Capacity = Lead-Acid Battery Capacity \* 75%. Then, replace the old charger with one that supports lithium batteries or ensure compatibility with your new battery's voltage. Remove the lead-acid batteries and disconnect ...
