Who is building a solar plant in Mali?

The government of Mali has announced the construction of a 200 MW solar plant on 314 hectares in the southwestern part of the country. The Sanankoroba solar plant will be built by Russia's Novawind, which is the renewable energy division of nuclear group Rosatom.

Why is Mali launching a 200 MWp solar power plant?

Will Mali build a solar power plant in 2024?

In recent weeks, Mali's transitional government has intensified efforts to implement this solution nationwide. On May 24, 2024, President Goïta visited Sanankoroba in the Kati Cercle to initiate the construction of the largest solar power plant in sub-Saharan Africa, covering 314 hectares.

How much energy does Mali produce?

A May 2023 report by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) stated that in 2020, Mali had a production capacity of 1,024.92 MW, including 162 MW from self-producers - all thermal. Electricity production stood 2,577.44 GWh, comprising 69% thermal energy, 26.8% hydroelectricity, and 4.2% solar.

How much PV capacity does Mali have?

According to the latest statistics from the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Mali had installed just 20 MW of PV capacity by the end of 2019. This content is protected by copyright and may not be reused.

Which company is constructing a new energy plant in Mali?

The Russian company NovaWind, a subsidiary of Rosatom, is constructing the plant, marking a significant step in the country's energy sector. In recent weeks, Mali's transitional government has intensified efforts to implement this solution nationwide.

The EUR77 million (\$91.3 million) PV plant is Mali's first IPP solar project. Akuo Energy secured a 28-year power purchase agreement for the array from Mali's power utility, Energie du...
