Where should a bee hive be placed?

Do NOT just place it in a random spot in your backyard and hope for the best. Place your beehive somewhere easily accessible, in a location that receives morning sunlight and is not subject to any substantial wind. This will protect the hive from harsh weather conditions and ensure your bees remain active.

How do you position a bee hive?

The best way to position your beehive is to put it in a location where it will get early morning sun and afternoon shade. This will give the bees the perfect temperature to work in. This will also give the bees the best chance of finding their way back to the hive when they're out foraging. You also need to make sure there is a windbreak in place.

They use the sun to orient themselves, so if the hive is in a shady spot, they can get lost. Make sure there are no trees or buildings blocking the sun so the bees can find their way home.
