Do I need permission to install solar panels in a conservation area?

Some Conservation Areas fall under Article 4 Directions which can include incredibly strict restrictions such as: Outside of Conservation Areas, the installation of solar panels falls under Permitted Development, meaning that you don't need to contact your local planning authority for permission.

Can solar panels be installed everywhere?

Solar panels cannot, however, be installed everywhere. There are several things you can and cannot do if the property you own or rent is in the conservation area. Solar panels can be set up in conservation areas although you need to tick all the boxes to get permission from the planning authorities.

What regulations apply when installing solar panels?

The following regulations apply when installing solar panels on listed buildings, in World Heritage Sites, or conservation areas: If you live in a conservation area and want to install solar panels, contact your local council who will decide if the changes you want to make will maintain the aesthetic of your area.

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels?

Usually, you don't need planning permission to install solar panels on your home under specific "permitted development" rules. However, if you live in a conservation area, you'll need to apply for planning permission because of stricter rules in these areas under what's known as Article 4 Directions.

Do non-domestic buildings need planning approval to install solar panels?

According to the government's extension of permitted development rights, non-domestic buildings no longer need to obtain planning approval in order to install solar PV or solar thermal systems. However, there are still some rules that remain, depending on whether it's a domestic or commercial solar panel installation:

Are solar panels more restricted if you live in a conservation area?

Solar panel installations may be more restricted if they disrupt the scenic value. To find out if you live in a conservation area, contact the local planning authority who will confirm whether your property is within a designated area.

Solar panels must not be installed on listed buildings or sites considered a monument. If installed on a roof, the roof must be shown to be strong enough to hold the solar panels. You may also need to apply for a Lawful Development ...
