

Where is St Barth & Le Saint-Martin located?

Approximately 250 kilometres (160 mi) east of Puerto Rico and the nearer Virgin Islands, St. Barth & Le Saint-Martin lies immediately southeast of the islands of Saint Martin and Anguilla. St. Barth & Le Saint-Martin is separated from Saint Martin by the Saint-Barth & Le Saint-Martin Channel. It lies northeast of Saba and St Eustatius, and north of St Kitts.
