



# St Kitts and Nevis bms for solar battery

Does St Kitts and Nevis have a national energy policy?

Yes, St. Kitts and Nevis has a National Energy Policy (NEP). The key provisions of this policy include connecting large-scale independent power providers and many distributed renewable energy systems to the electrical grid. Not all generation is made publically available; this chart provides known and referenceable data.

What is the standard voltage in Saint Kitts and Nevis?

The standard voltage in Saint Kitts and Nevis is 230 V. Visitors are expected to be courteous and conscious of existing rules and customs as they go about their tourism-related activities. The standard voltage in Saint Kitts and Nevis is 230 V and the standard frequency is 60 Hz.

How much does electricity cost in St Kitts & Nevis?

The electricity rates in the Federation of St. Christopher (St. Kitts) and Nevis are \$0.26 per kilowatt-hour (kWh). This is lower than the Caribbean regional average of \$0.33/kWh.

The solar PV will supply St. Kitts with 30 - 35% of the annual electricity demand utilising sustainable, solar energy with zero emissions. The solar and storage system will replace over 4,000,000 gallons of diesel per year.

The official ground-breaking ceremony of the Basseterre Valley Solar and Storage Project for a 35-megawatt solar energy plant and the 45-megawatt-hour battery storage facility was witnessed on December 10, 2020.

The largest solar generation plus energy storage project ever to be built in the Caribbean has been announced by the Government of St. Kitts and Nevis, the state-owned St. Kitts Electric Company (SKELEC) and Leclanch&#233; SA (SIX: LECN), one of the world"s leading energy storage companies.

Ground has been broken on the St Kitts microgrid while negotiations and developments continue with the Nevis Geothermal project.
