Viridity raised approximately \\$35 million in total. They received about \\$8 million in 2009 from initial investor AltEnergy, \\$8.5 million in 2010, \\$14 million in 2011 from Intel Capital and Braemar Energy Ventures, and \\$15 million in 2012 from Japan's Mitsui.

How much money did Viridity get from Altenergy?

Viridity raised about \$8 million from initial investor Altenergy. This is the amount Altenergy invested in Viridity.
